Restriction of Certain Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive 2011/65/EU

European Directive 2011/65/EU, "RoHS2" came into force in January, 2013. This directive restricts the maximum concentration of certain substances in electronic and electrical products.

The restricted substances are: -

Cadmium/cadmium compounds (0.01%); Hexavalent Chromium (0.1%); Lead/lead compounds (0.1%); Mercury/mercury compounds (0.1%); PBB - polybrominated biphenyls (0.1%) and PBDE - polybrominated diphenyl ethers (0.1%).

Exemptions: -

Exemptions to the RoHS Directive are permitted under Commission Decision 2010/571/EU published on 24 September 2010 and Commission Decision 011/534/EU published on 8 September 2011
